Winner Requirements

The winner of the award will be expected to write a short report (of about 500 words) and supply photos, on the completion of their project. The winner of the award will be named in our marketing materials and we hope will play a part in the promotion of the Award to the LEH alumnae network.

Terms and Conditions

- The award is to support enterprise and endeavour consistent with the ethos of the school.
- The deadline for submitting the application to the Alumnae Advisory Group (AAG) is Friday 4th November 2022. All applications submitted by the deadline shall be considered and adjudicated upon by the AAG. All decisions are final.
- The application for an award must be received in advance of the placement or project; grants are not provided retrospectively.
- The applicant must be an alumna of the School and will be registered on Holles Connect: www.hollesconnect.org.uk
- The applicant may nominate herself, or be nominated by a fellow alumna.
- The award is for endeavour and enterprise, not pleasure.
- The award must not be passed to another charity.
- The award will not normally exceed £1000 per applicant.
- Promptly following completion of the placement or project, the award holder will submit a written report. It is hoped that the award holder will also be willing to visit the School to speak to pupils about the placement or project, the contribution it has made and the impact it has had on the award holder.
